**We are almost finished trying the instruments. We have had a lot of fun. The instrument choice sheets are due to Mrs. G by Thursday, Sept. 7.**

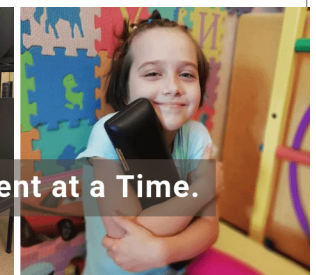
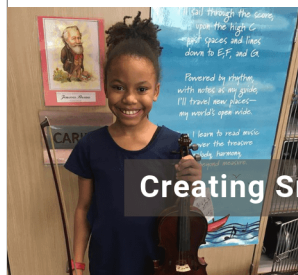
