Lesson 5: The Birth of Isaac

God blessed Abraham and Sarah with a baby boy – Isaac. This reminds us that babies are a special gift from God. Through the family of Abraham and Isaac, God sent another special baby – His Son, our Savior, Jesus. Through Jesus, we are all forgiven, saved, and named as children of God. We are part of His family through faith in Jesus!

Questions:

1. What was the promise God made with Abraham? (his family would have as many people as there are stars in the sky)
2. Why did Sarah laugh when she heard she would have a baby? (she was very old)

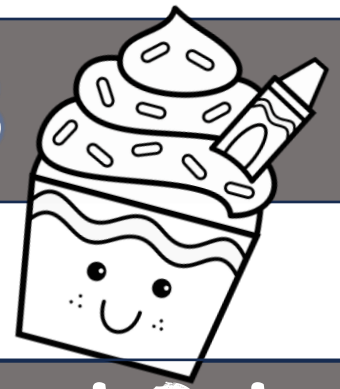
